Enabling Inclusive Growth for Farmers in Bihar

CDFI platform Kisan AdvaNcement through CasHless Innovation (KANCHI) is being used to digitise operations of 20 Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs) across 11 districts of Bihar under the Bihar Agriculture Growth Reforms Initiative (BAGRI) programme.

The project was officially inaugurated by Mr. Gavin McGillivray, Head, DFID India today with the implementation of KANCHI in the Dumraon Farm Producer Company Ltd (DFPCL) FPO in Buxar, Bihar. 
